Dear Residents,

As the holidays approach I wanted to extend a warm and heartfelt Season's Greetings to you all. I hope that you will be spending the holidays with your families and loved ones and reflecting on all that you have to be thankful for. I have a lot to be thankful for including my loving family and close friends. I'm also thankful for my colleagues on the Town Council and a successful first year in office as Mayor. We have accomplished much, with so much more to achieve.

Another thing I am thankful for is that we are finally wrapping up debris collection from Hurricane Irma. While we faced many challenges in the early days of the recovery effort that were beyond our control, Town staff and our vendors did a great job once they were at full staffing. Our initial estimate was that we would have approximately 200,000 cubic yards of debris to collect and we would be complete by January. As of this writing we have collected almost 300,000 cubic yards of debris and we are scheduling our final pass of storm related debris pickup for the first week in December. I would like to recognize our Town Engineer Rod Ley for directing the

debris removal effort in an efficient manner.

On another note, our Schools and Education Advisory Board hosted a Mr. & Mrs. Southwest Ranches Pageant recently and I would like to thank the Board for their efforts. I would also like to congratulate the winners: Bo Garcia, Seth Breeden, Reese Garcia, Wyatt Garcia, Savannah Hodgers, Madison Sullivan, and in other categories Brooke Giacin, Jake Garcia, Sophia Nardi, Alexandra Montgomery, and Brooke Breeden.

### **Brief legislation from the October 26, 2017 Town Council Regular Meeting:**

## **PROTOTYPE BARN**

In furtherance of the Town's goal of preserving its rural lifestyle, the



Town Council has given residents a simpler mechanism to build a barn that is in compliance with Florida statutory requirements. As such, the Town contracted with an architect who agreed to create a prototype barn drawing, in compliance with the Florida Building Code, which can be permitted for residents throughout the Town. The plans are for a three stall barn with a tack room.

A Town resident looking to build a barn can simply purchase a pre-drafted architectural plan from the Town, which they then can submit, at a reduced cost, and on an expedited basis, to get a permitted barn that will be in compliance with both state and local regulations.

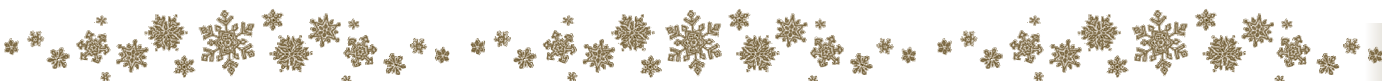

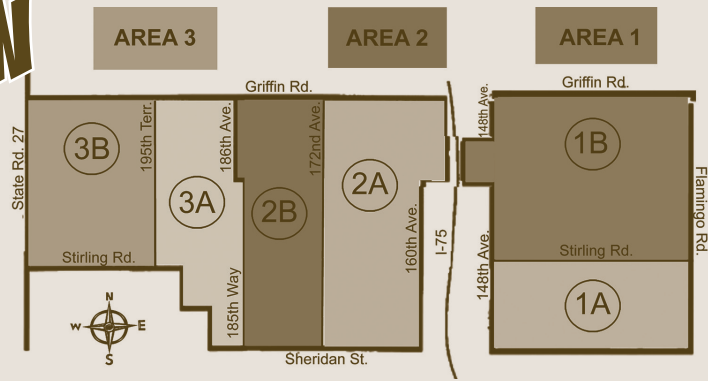

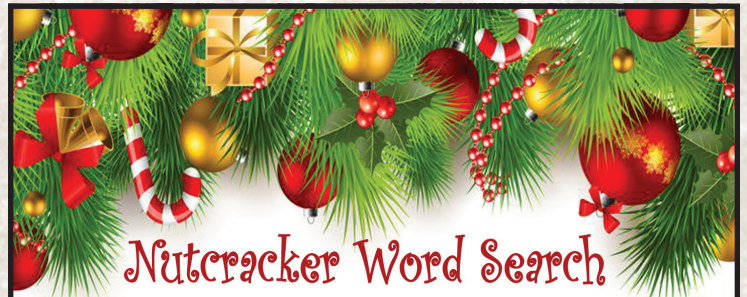
